Like walk leader, Kanika Singh, a historian, says, "Leading a walk, along with academic and management skill, importantly needs a personal touch."

Kanika, who has been leading

walks for a few years now, recalls how once she was told to lead a heritage walk for schoolkids, but surprisingly ended up with a group of hearing impaired children. "Had I known that before hand, I would have made arrangements to communicate more effectively. So, I decided to come up with DHW," she says.
