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Getting there

Where to Eat

A popular, no-frills restaurant overlooking the Hauz Khas reservoir, serving such simple South Indian dishes as sweet and sour pumpkin, flaky porattas and Coorg pork. Entrees start at around \$5.

What to do

Delhi's heritage sites are often unmarked and difficult to find. Hire a car service such as Metropole (metrovista.co.in) for the day and bring along a detailed Eicher Delhi City Map (maps.eicherworld.com), which points out landmarks, and Lucy Peck's exhaustive guidebook, "[Delhi: A Thousand Years of Building](#)" (Roli Books, 2005, available in bookstores or on Amazon.com).
